#### In Brief: February 2014

 4 Requirements Met, 0 Proposed. The Federal Reserve released a final rule that establishes enhanced prudential standards for U.S. bank holding companies and foreign banking organizations. We have launched an enhanced prudential standards resources website, available at <u>USBasel3.com/EPS</u>.


#### State of Play to Date:

- In the past month, no rulemaking requirement deadlines passed, no rulemaking requirements were proposed, and one rule was finalized that meets four rulemaking requirements.
- As of March 3, 2014, a total of 280 Dodd-Frank rulemaking requirement deadlines have passed. This is 70.4% of the 398 total rulemaking requirements, and 100% of the 280 rulemaking requirements with specified deadlines.
- Of these 280 passed deadlines, 128 (45.7%) have been missed and 152 (54.3%) have been met with finalized rules. Regulators have not yet released proposals for 56 of the 128 missed rules.
- Of the 398 total rulemaking requirements, 205 (51.5%) have been met with finalized rules and rules have been proposed that would meet 83 (20.9%) more. Rules have not yet been proposed to meet 110 (27.6%) rulemaking requirements.

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
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# Davis Polk Dodd-Frank Rulemaking Progress by Month




# **Davis Polk** Dodd-Frank Rulemaking Progress by Agency







Number of Required Rulemakings (Joint Rules are Counted for Each Applicable Agency)


# **Davis Polk** Dodd-Frank Rulemaking Progress by Due Date

# Dodd-Frank Statutory Deadlines for Required Rulemakings



# Davis Polk Dodd-Frank Study Progress by Due Date




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### Dodd-Frank Statutory Deadlines for Required Studies
